### Why do you choose to volunteer with BUST Breast Cancer?

Five years ago, a dear friend of mine, breast cancer survivor, and former BUST Breast Cancer Model, Courtney Edwards, invited me to a BUST Breast Cancer meeting. I realized it was much more than just volunteering. After seeing the impact BUST has on our community, I knew this was my opportunity to give back to an organization that gave so much to me.

### Why is Woman's important to our community?

Woman's contributes so much to women's health and wellness throughout the state. In addition to cancer awareness, diagnosis, treatment, and prevention, Woman's provides support to new mothers and their babies.

### How has Woman's made a difference in your life?

Both of my daughters were born at Woman's. The birth of my first daughter required an emergency C-section resulting in NICU care. The staff were extremely comforting and supportive during this time, and my daughter's care was exceptional.

Before my second daughter was born, I had a miscarriage. I had to go to Woman's, and they took such wonderful care of me. When my second daughter arrived, she was also admitted to the NICU. Once again, the care of the NICU nurses and staff was always comforting and helpful through this difficult time.

### What do you hope to accomplish through your volunteer work?

I want to be a role model to my daughters and to anyone who has the opportunity to give their time to help others. I believe God works through us in unique ways, and volunteering allows me to share my talents to help others and serve our community. He gives us a heart to share and not keep to ourselves. We are here to help and love others.
